## Key New Features

- Support for migration of simple PDS Documents to the new DRS
- New version of Batch Builder ([2.0.61](#)) that includes bug fixes and enhancements
- Numerous bug fixes and enhancements in new DRS Web Admin

## Enhancements and Bug Fixes in Detail

### Web Admin:

- File list table width has been updated to better fit the screen
- Added support for Harvard Metadata Link display label
- Fixed bulk edit “Select All” function
- Fixed the issue with adding GIFs to PDS objects in structure editor
- “Add URN” link is no longer hidden when no other delivery URNs are present
- File summary now displays correctly when viewing TIFFs with JPEG compression
- Object list table in batch summary view now includes pagination widget

### Batch Builder:

- HAS\_DOCUMENTATION relationships are now generated between all audio and ADL files
- Added ability to extract audio file checksums from AES-57 files in advanced audio workflow
- Updated OTS (Object Tool Set) to version 1.0.12 to support TIFFs with JPEG compression
- Updated FITS (File Information Tool Set) to version 0.8.5 (includes updated OTS 1.0.12)
